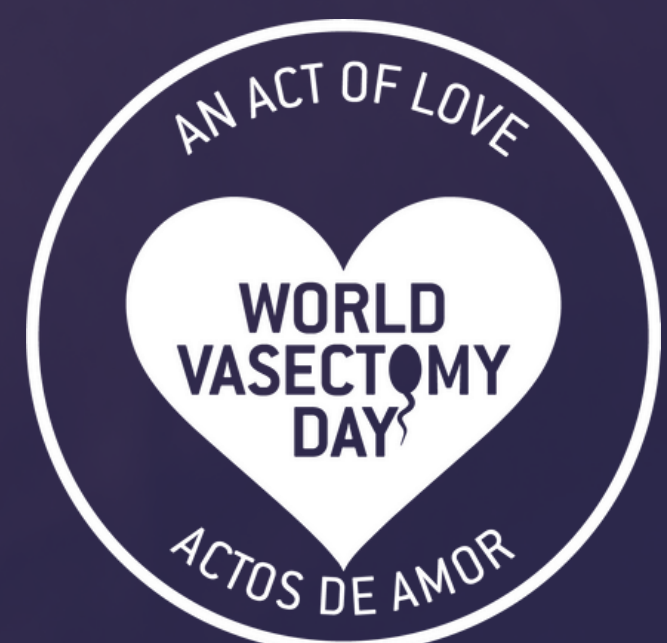
1. Describe clinical conditions that can lead to technically difficult vasectomies.
